Rules The competition will be carried out according to the UIPM Rules.

- Swimming: 50m swimming pool / 8 lanes
- Fencing: 10 pistes
- Laser Run:
- shooting range (service: PENTASHOT): 36+2 precision laser targets
- o running course: 800m, country loop, grass/gravel



Training

The LOC will offer training facilities for all venues (swimming pool, fencing hall and laser run course from June 02, 2019.

Accommodation

We inform that in order to provide athletes the best conditions for their stay and to ensure swift run of the competition the accommodation will be held within WOSiR facilities in Drzonków.



Please note that the Technical Meeting, Accreditation Office and LOC Office and etc. will be located in the WOSiR Drzonków.

Rooms are reserved on a first come first served basis so if one category becomes full, it will no longer be possible to choose this option.



Transport

LOC guarantee transportation from the national airport Zielona Góra – Babimost and Railway Station in Zielona Góra to the official hotels and the return journey. In special cases it is possible to transport the Delegation from the Berlin airport, after prior notification and agreement of the financial conditions with the Organizer (LOC). The LOC will also provide transport from the Berlin Airports, Wroclaw Airport and Poznan Airport. The cost is 350€/bus(8 peoples)/round trip or 300€/car(3 peoples)/round trip

Transportation from the official hotels to the venue for athletes will be according to the competition programme.

If you do not complete the information required prior to the deadline, or we do not receive your delegation's deposit payment, then we will assume that your delegation is not participating.

Financial

For delegations (athletes, coaches, officials, supporters) reserving the conditions accommodation package, the prices are as follows:

Hotel	Before 09.05.2019	After 09.05.2019
Single room*	150€	160€
Double/Triple room	125€	135€

This price includes full board accommodation, local transportation from/to the event. Delegations wishing to arrange their own accommodation must pay an accreditation fee per participant (athlete, coach or official) to the LOC. The amount of the Accreditation fee is set at EUR 75 per day per person, a minimum payment of 4 days. For this, we will provide lunch packets for the competition days and allow access to official transportation between the competition hotel and competition sites.

The check out hour is 12.00 am. If the delegates will stay more time must pay additionally for accommodation and/or meal ($\frac{1}{2}$ day). Please inform the LOC about extension of the extra day and extra meal. * Single rooms are limited.

At the same time as submitting the Final Entry Forms all NFs must send to the LOC by electronic bank transfer or other means, 30% of the total amount of their accommodation invoice, otherwise their reservation will not be guaranteed. Following closure of the registration system on the 9th May 2019, a NF must enter

the competition with at least one pentathlete/team per confirmed gender or Mix Relay. Any failure to take part having sent their final entries will pay a fine of 600 € to the LOC.

Athletes

Athletes are only allowed to participate in UIPM sanctioned events if they are in License - possession of a valid Athletes License. Registration is not possible without a License Number. If an athlete does not have a license they will not be allowed to take part in the competition.

Insurance - According to UIPM Rules all members of attending delegations should insure themselves in case of accidental injury or illness. The organizer will not accept any responsibility financial or other, for any loss, injury or illness of any member of the delegation.

Visas and vaccination

Visiting NFs should confirm visa and vaccination requirements for entry into POLAND prior travelling to the event. The LOC cannot accept responsibility for arranging visas but can provide specific letters of invitation if needed. For information if you need a visa or vaccinations please contact your nearest Embassy or Consulate.
