COMPETITION RULES

The competition will be carried out according to the UIPM Rules. Swimming: 50m indoor heated swimming pool / 6 lanes Fencing (Ranking Round): 9+1 indoor pistes Fencing (Bonus Round): 1 outside show-piste with the roof Fencing (Mixed-Relay): 12 indoor piste (Depending on number of teams) Laser-Run: 36+2 reserve lanes with Dr. Schneider Laser Precision Targets Running course: Grass, Tartan track

Athletes will qualify for the WC Final 2019 according to UIPM Rules 1.19.4. Final list will be published following UIPM WC 4 - 2019.

The highest placed athlete of each gender will earn a quota place for the Tokyo2020 Olympic Games, according to **QUALIFICATION SYSTEM – GAMES OF THE XXXII OLYMPIAD – Tokyo 2020 2019 UIPM World Cup Final – Tokyo (JPN)**

TRANSPORT

Transportation from both Haneda and Narita Airport to the official hotel and the return journey is only guaranteed if flight information is provided in the registration system prior to the deadline.









Transportation between the official hotel to the venues will be provided according to the training and competition program.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

For delegations (athletes, coaches, officials, supporters) reserving full board.

Registration fees -Single EUR 210 -Twin EUR 190

Number of Room Types Available: -Single 110 -Double 80

Each price includes full board accommodation, breakfast (buffet), lunch (lunch box at the venue), Dinner (buffet), local transportation from / to the event and shuttle from / to the Airport.

Delegations who wish to arrange their own accommodation must pay an accreditation fee per participant (athlete, coach, or official) to the LOC. The amount of the accreditation fee is set at EUR 100 per day per person with a minimum payment of 4 days EUR 400. In this case, we will provide lunch boxes for the competition sites and allow access to official transportation between the hotel and competition sites.

ATTENTION! All extra cost for bank transfer should be worn by the national federation. Otherwise, the amount will be invoiced afterwards.

Paying cash upon arrival is only accepted if you have a written approval from the LOC to do so and all financial conditions (costs) will be calculated on the prices mentioned above.

As a reminder, if on arrival at the competition, teams arriving with fewer athletes and/or officials than submitted in the registration system and without informing the Organizing Nation/LOC at least 7 days prior to their arrival, the NF will have to pay a fine to the Organizing Nation/LOC of EUR 230 for each person not attending

DEADLINES

Delegations are kindly reminded that the UIPM Online Registration system is obligatory.









The online system will be open from May 27, 2019. All information must be submitted, including flight information, pistol serial numbers, accommodation bookings, etc. by June 3 and June 14 (for reallocated places), 2019. Any changes after this must be sent by email to the organizer. <u>kingo@adagio.ocn.ne.jp</u>

Following closure of the registration system, a NF must enter the competition with at least one pentathlete/team per confirmed gender or Mixed-Relay. Any failure to take part after having sent their final entries will pay a fine of EUR 600 to the UIPM.

Deadlines are as follows:

- 1. Online entry of confirmed athletes, coaches and officials before June 3 and 14 for reallocated places
- 2. Deadline to transfer total amount June 7 and 14 (for reallocated places)
- 3. 2019 Closure of Registration June 7 and 14 (for reallocated places)

If we do not receive complete information of your delegation prior to closure of the registration system or we do not receive your delegation's payment, confirmation then we will consider your delegation as non-participating

ATHLETES LICENSES/ RIDING ABILITY

Athletes are only allowed to participate in UIPM sanctioned events, if they are in possession of a valid UIPM issued Athletes License. Registration is not possible without a License Number. If an athlete does not have a license, they will not be allowed to take part in the competition.

You are kindly reminded of UIPM Rule 1.12.1 ii): Pentathletes without riding ability listed in the database and without a letter/certificate from their NF confirming their ability to ride cannot compete at World Cup Final.

Please note, if an athlete will show insufficient riding ability or dangerous riding, she/he can be stopped by Technical Officials at any time during warm-up or competition. UIPM might also ask for video footage prior to the World Cup Final.

INSURANCE

According to UIPM Rules all members of attending delegations should insure themselves in case of accidental injury or illness.

The organizer will not accept any responsibility such as financial, loss, injury or illness occurred to any participant and or member of delegation.

LASER PISTOLS

Firearms licenses are not a legal requirement when bringing air and CO2 pistols (cylinders for laser pistols) into Japan for competition purposes. However, please note the pistol model and serial number must be entered into the UIPM system.









VISAS & VACCINATIONS

All delegates should confirm visa and vaccination requirements for entry into Japan prior travelling to the competition. For information if you need a visa or vaccinations please contact your nearest Embassy or Consulate.

The LOC cannot accept responsibility for arranging visas but can provide specific letters of invitation if needed.
